The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA, is the process by which those interested in the Catholic faith are invited to inquire about the Church, and if they so desire, join the worldwide Catholic community. RCIA provides the outline for this entire process as well as the ritual celebrations marking entry into the Catholic faith. God is ultimately the one who calls a person to such a life-changing experience. All that is needed is an open heart to his word and trust in the journey he sets before you. Throughout the process of Christian initiation, usually lasting about a year, the entire Church promises to be there for those wishing to grow in their Christian faith. The Church stands by to patiently water and nourish and cultivate new seeds of faith, trusting in the Lord to provide a great harvest.
