

Parishioner Guidelines for Public Masses

June 2020

Attendance will be limited. Churches will reopen at a 25% seating capacity (SSPP's would be about 75). With fewer people at each Mass, it may not be possible for all to attend on the weekends. Some may need to choose one of the weekday Masses. (The Bishop has dispensed all Catholics in the diocese of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass through June 30.)

Social Distancing will be practiced. Pews will be taped off to achieve proper social distancing. Individuals who are not members of the same household will need to sit at least 6 feet away from others in all directions.

Masks or face coverings will be required. Those 2 years of age or older should bring and wear their own face covering. Parents, we know this will be hard with young children; just do your best.

Holy Communion may not be received in the hand if you are wearing gloves.

Mass will look different. No physical greetings. The Precious Blood will not be distributed. Collection baskets will not be passed. You can give online or by mail, or place your donation in a basket upon your arrival or departure from Mass.

Extra sanitization has been put in place. Please see the bulletin for details. However, you are encouraged to bring your own hand sanitizer, if you wish additional sanitization.
