FIRST RECONCILIATION - RETREAT AND CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT - SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 26th, 2022 (2nd Grade)

Preparation for First Reconciliation occurs during the 2nd grade catechetical year. Classes begin Sunday, September 12, 2021. Parents are required to attend an informational parent meeting, tentatively scheduled for Sunday, October 17th, 2021. Children/parents will gather in the morning on Saturday, February 26th, for a Reconciliation Retreat, prior to the reception of the Sacrament.

FIRST EUCHARIST RETREAT - FRIDAY, MAY 20th, 2022 (2nd Grade), and FIRST EUCHARIST - CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT - SATURDAY, MAY 21st, 2022

Preparation for First Eucharist occurs, along with preparation for First Reconciliation, during the 2nd grade catechetical year. Parents are required to attend a parent meeting, tentatively scheduled for Sunday, March 27th, 2022. There is also a First Communion Retreat for children and parents scheduled for Friday, May 20th, 2022, which includes rehearsal for receiving the Sacrament on May 21st, 2022. First Reconciliation (see above) must be celebrated before First Eucharist.

CONFIRMATION - FALL 2021 (9th Grade)

Preparation for Fall 2021 Confirmation will begin Sunday, August 1st, 2021. This start date is earlier than usual due to the need to make up for missed preparation sessions due to Covid-19. Preparation includes a one day retreat (uncertain for this year) and candidate/parent/sponsor meetings one Sunday a month during class time (see schedule). Confirmation will take place at the Cathedral of St. Andrew in Grand Rapids, on a date in late October or early November as determined by the diocese.

CONFIRMATION - FALL 2022 (8th Grade)

Preparation for Confirmation BEGINS in the 8th grade catechetical year. Candidates are confirmed in the first semester of their 9th grade year. Classes begin Sunday, September 12, 2021. We employ the Decision Point Confirmation program provided by Dynamic Catholic (Matthew Kelly). Preparation includes an initial parent/candidate meeting (scheduled for October 10th, 2021, during class), along with candidate/parent/sponsor information sharing meetings one Sunday per month, during regular class time, after January 1st, 2022 (see schedule).
