#### **Parking Lot Report**

We first began talking about the need to repair the parking lot in April when the snow melted and revealed just how large the cracks in our lot had become. Now, eight months later, we have the job done! It went though many stages. At first we thought we could simply tear up the section of the parking lot nearest the wall and pour new concrete for a cost of roughly \$36,000. A closer examination of the wall revealed how far it had bulged out in the center and just how compromised it had become. It clearly needed to be replaced. We also found out that the drains in the parking lot were part of the problem and needed work to prevent water from making its way to the wall in the first place. Finally, the fence on top of the wall would need to be removed and reinstalled. These additions brought the cost of the project up to an estimate of \$193,000.

We could not begin the project until it had been presented to the diocese and received approval, but work finally began at the end of August. CL Trucking was the main contractor, and they did the preliminary tear down of the old wall and removal of the section of parking lot to be replaced. They did the excavation and preparation of the site for the next step, which was the pouring of the footing for the new wall, followed by the pouring of the new wall itself. This was done by Goose Creek Foundations. Once the wall had cured for a few days, CL Trucking returned to backfill the area behind the wall.

Platte Brothers Concrete came in at this point to pour the sidewalks and the first section of the parking lot. The drains were repaired and new PVC pipes to connect them were installed by CL Trucking, and then the final section of the parking lot was poured. Once this had cured, CL Trucking put in temporary black top to fill in the narrow space between the old parking lot and the new. Next year we will decide where to go from here.

The final step of the process was to reinstall the fence on the top of the wall. The original estimate to have this done was for nearly \$13,000. This seemed extraordinarily high, so a group of parishioners led by Glen Trierweiler decided to handle that project themselves. This was not as straightforward as it might seem because the new wall did not have dimensions identical to the old one, and new fasteners had to be designed. Eventually we came up with a plan to use brackets which fit on top of the wall to secure the fence. These were constructed by CL Trucking and have worked very well, even better than the original installation had been.

We were blessed as this project went along by several very generous donations which helped lower the final cost. First, HSV Redi-Mix of Lake Odessa came forward and offered to donate all the concrete for the project, a value of \$34,000. Platte Brothers gave us a 10% discount on the cost of their work which amounted to \$2,500. Finally, CL Trucking discounted their cost to the parish by \$27,500. By doing the fence installation ourselves, we saved nearly an additional \$10,000. When all was said and done, the entire project cost \$109,113.38.
