Statement regarding the Education Choice Petition Drive

I want to provide you with an update regarding the Let MI Kids Learn (LMKL) drive which Michigan Catholic Conference (MCC) supported last year on behalf of Michigan's Catholic bishops, to improve access and choice for education in Michigan and to help more public and private low-income students afford the education resources thev need.

Thanks to the efforts of many volunteers across the state, LMKL successfully collected more than the minimum number of signatures to get the scholarship proposal to the Legislature, which could have approved it without the Governor's signature. This was necessary because the Governor had vetoed similar legislation in 2021, which prompted the signature-gathering drive to commence in 2022. LMKL submitted the petitions for validation to the state in August 2022, past the deadline for consideration for the 2022 ballot, which is where the petition would have gone if the Legislature did not approve it. Because of that, the state had until June 2024 to evaluate the signatures.

Since the submission of the signatures, The November election changed control of the Legislature from Republicans – who have previously signaled their support to approve the education scholarship program - to Democrats. Despite efforts by LMKL to persuade the state to finish evaluating the signatures and allow the proposal to go before the previous Legislature, the legislative majority changed hands and the state did not finish evaluation of the signatures.

It is unlikely that the new legislative majority would approve the program, meaning the proposal would go to the ballot in 2024. That would require millions of dollars in resources to try to get it approved by the voters. Because of this reality, the LMKL committee made the decision to withdraw the signatures submitted to the state, which has been granted, thus ending the initiative to implement the scholarship program.

While this is a disappointing outcome, MCC will continue to work toward and look for opportunities to improve education choice in Michigan and aid parents in their roles as the primary educators of their children. I am grateful for the effort that parishes and Catholic schools provided. Please convey my gratitude to those in your community who assisted in this cause. I wish you the best in the New Year.




Knights' Corner


