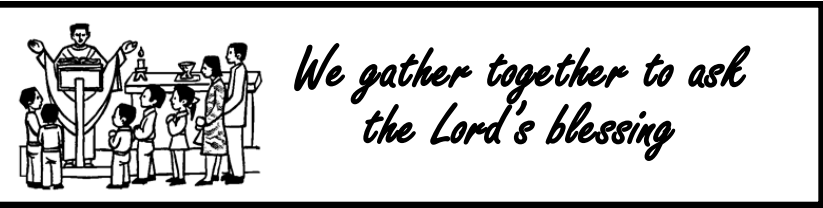

Welcome, Fr. Hubert Kavusa, OSC

The Diocese of Grand Rapids has designated the Crosier Fathers and Brothers to make a mission appeal at SS. Peter & Paul and St. Edward Parishes. We welcome Fr. Hubert Kavusa to our parishes this weekend. He will be presiding at all the English Masses.

The Crosier Fathers and Brothers are one of the oldest religious orders in the Roman Catholic Church. The order was founded by Blessed Theodore de Celles in 1210 in what is now the Diocese of Liege, in Belgium. Eight centuries later, Crosiers are located worldwide in Europe (Belgium, the Netherlands, and Italy); North America (United States); South America (Brazil); Asia (Indonesia); and Africa (Democratic Republic of the Congo).

Our mission, to touch suffering with hope, is rooted in the spirituality of the Glorious Cross. In the midst of a suffering world, we strive to bear witness to the glory of the resurrection. Grounded in the Rule of Saint Augustine, our charism is

supported by the following three pillars: Cultus (liturgy of the Church), Communio (community life), and Caritas (ministry to the poor).

The Crosier Fathers and Brothers serve in poor parishes and schools in three areas of Indonesia: Java, Papua and Nias. Papua and Nias are among the poorest islands of Indonesia. Indonesia is the fourth largest national population in the world, coming right after the United States. Six hundred tribes live on Indonesia’s 17,000 islands. Indonesia has the largest Muslim population in the world. Catholics in Indonesia make up only 7% of the population and are spread across 38 dioceses.

A huge priority for us is the training of the next generations of Indonesian Crosiers. This year, we have 45 seminarians in Indonesia. The cost to support and educate one seminarian is about \$10,000 a year. The Crosier Fathers and Brothers need your help so that they can continue to provide good religious and priestly formation in the largest Muslim country in the world.
