#### The Call to Sainthood

On September 7, 2025, the Catholic Church celebrated a significant moment in its history by canonizing two remarkable individuals: Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati. Their elevation to Sainthood was a testament to their extraordinary lives of faith, dedication, and love for God.

Carlo Acutis, a young Italian boy who lived in the late 20th cen-



tury, exemplified his devotion through his enthusiastic embrace of the Eucharist and his deep understanding of technology, using it to spread the Gospel message to young people. He demonstrated that holiness can be achieved in our modern

world, serving as a beacon of faith for many.

Pier Giorgio Frassati, known for his adventurous spirit and commitment to social justice, dedicated his life to serving those in need. He embodied the teachings of Christ through his compassionate actions and tireless advocacy for the marginalized and the poor. His joyful demeanor and active participation in the Church's mission were an inspiration to all.



Both saints embody what it means to say

"yes" to God daily, striving to follow the path laid out by Jesus Christ. They serve as role models, demonstrating how to fully surrender oneself to God's will and mission. Saints play a crucial role in our spiritual lives, interceding on our behalf and guiding us through their lived examples and teachings. Through their stories, we are reminded of the call to holiness and the joy of living a life devoted to God and others.

Su actitud alegre y su participación activa en la misión de la Iglesia fueron una inspiración para todos.

Ambos santos encarnan lo que significa decir «sí» a Dios cada día, esforzándose por seguir el camino trazado por Jesucristo. Son modelos a seguir, que demuestran cómo entregarse plenamente a la voluntad y la misión de Dios. 
