The Office of Communications of the Diocese of Grand Rapids has asked all parishes to post the following statement regarding the religious order Trinitarians of Mary. The Trinitarians have had a local convent in our diocese for several vears.

## **Trinitarians of Mary**

As previously announced by the diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-vear visitation. the Apostolic See (specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life) by means of a Decree dated May 12, 2022, and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

#### Trinitarios de María

Como se anunció anteriormente por la diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y Sociedades de Vida Apostólica) mediante un Decreto fechado el 12 de mayo de 2022, y aprobado en forma específica por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como los Trinitarios de María. Con esta supresión, los antiguos miembros de los Trinitarios fueron automáticamente dispensados de sus votos y ya no se les permite presentarse como religiosos. No hay derecho de apelación, y los Trinitarios han dejado de existir como un instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.


