A Letter from Father Eugene

In a few weeks, the Catholic Church will begin the liturgical season of Lent. It will begin with the distribution of ashes, a symbol and a clarion call to repentance and belief in the Gospel. The Church will be called and challenged to practice almsgiving, prayer, and fasting. Many will reflect on and meditate on the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Some will make an intentional act of mortification through abstinence and other forms of atonement.

The season of Lent provides an opportunity for us to experience a moment of grace amid the practice of sacrifice. This sacrificial grace opens our hearts to know and receive the love of God. Grace is freely given to those who are open to receiving it. But it comes with the prize of Christ giving Himself completely for our sanctification.

As we enter and prepare ourselves for Lent, let us open our hearts to the transformative power of Jesus Christ. May this time be a moment of grace for you, and may grace carry you through the offering of sacrifice.


