A Letter from the Bishop Una carta del Obispo

Dear friends in Christ,

This year marks the 800th anniversary of St. Francis of Assisi's passage from earthly life. To mark the occasion, Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a Holy Year of Saint Francis, to be celebrated from January 10, 2026, to January 10, 2027. Our Holy Father invites everyone to rediscover and live the message of peace, fraternity, and reconciliation inspired by the Poor Man of Assisi.

A plenary indulgence is available under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father) to all the faithful who take part in the Year of Saint Francis. Visit the diocesan website, GRdiocese.org, for more details.

In the Diocese of Grand Rapids, we are blessed to have the Franciscan Sisters of the Eucharist. Our diocesan Vicar for Evangelization has been in conversation with this community so that the grace of this Year may reach throughout our local Church. To that end, I invite you to the following opportunities to mark the Jubilee Year:

Mass and Education Sessions- every second Saturday of the month through January 2027 at 10 a.m., I will preside at Mass in the chapel at the Franciscan Life Process Center (FLPC) in Lowell. After Mass, the sisters will educate us on one of the charisms of Saint Francis.

Penance Service- Sunday, Aug. 2 at 7 p.m. in the FLPC chapel. I, along with 15 priests, will be available to hear confessions.

The Feast of St. Francis of Assisi- Sunday, Oct. 4 at 3 p.m. at the Cathedral of Saint Andrew. I will celebrate Mass to mark the feast day. A reception will follow at Cathedral Square Center.

Quiet prayer- Monday-Friday from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. in the FLPC chapel. The chapel is open for the faithful of our Diocese who wish to spend quiet time in prayer.

"Our times are not very different from those in which Francis lived, and precisely in light of this, his teachings are perhaps even more valid and understandable today" (Decree). Please join me for these events so that we may imitate St. Francis and be channels of peace in our troubled world.

Oración en Silencio: La capilla del Franciscan Life Process Center estará abierta de lunes a viernes, de 9:00 a.m. a 4:00 p.m. para los fieles de nuestra diócesis que deseen pasar un rato de oración en silencio.

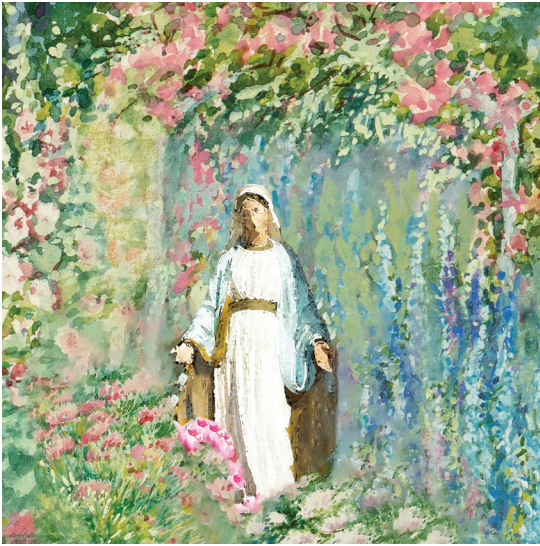
