A Letter from Father Eugene Una carta del Padre Eugene

An Excerpt from Pope Leo XIV First Encyclical Letter

On May 25, 2026, the day after Pentecost, Pope Leo XIV signed his first Encyclical Letter entitled, Magnifica Humanitas, (Magnificent Humanity). He addresses the dignity, beauty and wonder of man in an era of Artificial Intelligence. Below is an excerpt of his letter which speaks of the inherent dignity of man as created in the image and likeness of the Triune God especially on this Sunday when we celebrate the Holy Trinity.

I encourage everyone to read it in its entirety. A link is provided below.

The human person: image of the Triune God

48. *The Church's Social Doctrine brings us to the very heart of our faith: the mystery of the living God, revealed in Jesus Christ, who, as a communion of Persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – is love itself in relationship, expressed in the mutual gift of self and in sharing with the world. As the Council recalled, human persons are called to communion with God and “can fully discover their true selves only in sincere self-giving.” Indeed their deepest vocation is to enter into the Trinitarian dynamic of love received and shared.*

50. *At the heart of the Christian understanding of the human person lies the great biblical affirmation that men and women are created in the image and likeness (cf. Gen 1:26–27) of the Triune God. Created for relationship, every human person is planned and willed by God to enter into communion with him, with others and with creation. Human dignity does not depend on a person's abilities, wealth or position in life, nor on the right or wrong choices made; instead, it is a gift that precedes and transcends each person, endowed by God as an expression of his unfailing love. For this reason, the human person always remains the “way for the Church” and the heart of every authentic path of integral human development.*

Un extracto de la primera encíclica del Papa León XIV

El 25 de mayo de 2026, día posterior a Pentecostés, el Papa León XIV firmó su primera encíclica titulada 'Magnífica Humanitas'. En ella aborda la dignidad, belleza y maravilla del ser humano en una era de Inteligencia Artificial. A continuación, se presenta un extracto de su carta que habla de la dignidad inherente del hombre, creado a imagen y semejanza del Dios Trino, especialmente en este domingo en el que celebramos la Santísima Trinidad.

El ser humano, imagen del Dios trinitario

48. *La Doctrina social de la Iglesia nos conduce al corazón mismo de nuestra fe: el misterio del Dios viviente, revelado en Jesucristo como comunión de personas; Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo: amor en relación, que se da recíprocamente y se comunica al mundo. Como recuerda el Concilio, el ser humano está llamado a la comunión con Dios y «no puede encontrar su propia plenitud si no es en la entrega sincera de sí mismo»; su vocación más profunda es la de entrar en el movimiento trinitario del amor recibido y compartido.*

50. *En el centro de la visión cristiana del ser humano está la gran afirmación según la cual el hombre y la mujer son creados “a imagen y semejanza” (cf. Gn1,26-27) del Dios trinitario. Cada persona, hecha constitutivamente para la relación, es pensada y querida por Dios para entrar en una historia de comunión con Él, con los demás y con la creación. Su dignidad no depende de las capacidades que posee, de las riquezas o del rol que desempeña, ni de las decisiones justas o equivocadas que toma, sino que es un don que la precede y la excede, dado por Dios como expresión de su amor que nunca falla. Por eso, la persona humana permanece siempre como «el camino primero y fundamental de la Iglesia» y el corazón de toda auténtica vía de desarrollo humano integral.*

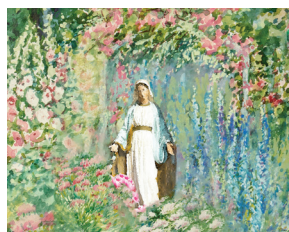

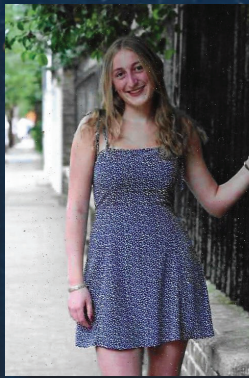

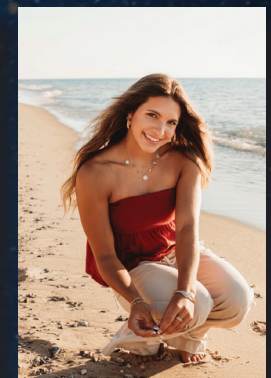
